High School Mission Trip to New Orleans: This 2013 February break (Sunday February 17 to Saturday February 23, 2013), our high school youth group and some friends will travel to Camp Restore in New Orleans. Camp Restore is a volunteer camp in the 9th Ward of New Orleans LA. The volunteers and staff will physically rebuild dwellings, churches, and schools, and participate in numerous community service projects. We will be participating in environmental and community service projects the week we are there, as well as seeing New Orleans.

There is much to do as we plan for our trip! This fall we will be running a letter writing campaign, a holiday babysitting fund-raiser, and asking for general donations to help us fund the trip. We are hoping to raise money to cover transportation (airplanes and vans), and room and board. Food and lodging is about \$35 a day per person, round trip airfare is about \$800 a ticket and vans about \$1000 each for the week. Here is an overview of upcoming fundraisers. We will be:

- Auctioning a **New Orleans Dinner** at the Parish Auction... YUM!!
- Taking **Pie Orders** for delivery before Thanksgiving
- Running TWO Babysitting Fundraisers after church **Sunday December 9** and **December 16**. Parents can leave their children for the afternoon with the high school youth for some 'kid free' shopping. -- kids had a blast last year!
